Hugh Lincoln Hinson, 86, of Albemarle, passed away Sunday August 25, 2019 at the Tucker Hospice House, Kannapolis, NC. His funeral service will be 1 Pm Wednesday August 28, 2019 at Pine Grove United Methodist Church with Rev. Brad Hinton officiating. There will be a 30 minute viewing prior to the service. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends in the Church Fellowship Hall following the service.

Hugh was born February 12, 1933 in Stanly County, NC and was the son of the late Fred Hinson and Mary Victoria Hahn Hinson. Mr. Hinson retired from Metal Forge and was a Veteran of the United States Air Force, having served as a B-29 Bomber Mechanic. He was a lifetime member of Pine Grove United Methodist Church, where he was a past Sunday School Teacher, Lay Leader and choir member. Hugh was a master woodworker building custom furniture and cabinets.
