Mr. Frank Ivey Lambert, Sr., 90, of Albemarle, passed away Saturday, August 23, 2015 in the VA Hospital, Salisbury, NC. His funeral service will be 11 AM Saturday, August 29, 2015 in the Stanly Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Adam Hatley officiating. Burial will follow in Fairview Memorial Park with Full Military Rites by the Stanly County DAV Ritual Team. The family will receive friends at Stanly Funeral Home from 9:30 until 10:30 prior to the hour of the service.

Born November 24, 1924 in Stanly County, NC, he was the son of the late David Arthur Lambert and Sallie Kimrey Lambert and was a graduate of Albemarle High School Class of 1942.
