Lane O'Brion Burris Sr., 71, of Locust passed away Friday, May 19, 2017 in CHS-Northeast, Concord, NC. His funeral service will be 2 PM Tuesday, May 23, 2017 in Liberty Hill Primitive Baptist Church. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends on Monday evening from 6 until 8 PM at Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care, Albemarle.

Born April 16, 1946 in Stanly County, NC he was the son of the late Ralph Lane Burris and Victoria Eudy Burris. He was a retired Captain with the Stanly County Sheriff's Department. He was of the Christian Faith. Mr. Burris loved people and he loved Stanly County. He ran a very close race in 2016 for a seat in the NC House of Representatives, carrying Stanly County. He also loved to hunt and fish.

Mr. Burris is survived by his wife of 50 years, Janice Honeycutt Burris.
