George Randy Shields, 72, of Albemarle passed away Wednesday, December 13, 2017 in his home. His funeral service will be 2 PM Saturday at Canton Baptist Church with Rev. Mark Mabry and Rev. Gary Hunsucker officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends on Friday evening from 6 until 8 PM at Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care.
