Fred Leon Dunagan, 84, of Oakboro, passed away Wednesday, October 31, 2018 at his home. His funeral service will be Sunday, November 4, 2018 at 2:00 pm in the Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care Chapel of Locust. Burial will follow at Oakboro Cemetery in Oakboro, NC. The family will receive friends from 1PM to 2PM prior to the service.

Born July 22, 1934 in Narrows, VA, Mr. Dunagan was the son of the late William Rexford Dunagan and Ethel Wall Dunagan. Fred attended West Oakboro Baptist Church and was a retired area manager with BP Oil Co. in Charlotte, NC. He was a veteran of the United States Marine Corps and served during the Korean War.
