**G**oldwyn Smith Russell, 95, of Salisbury, NC, passed away Wednesday November 7, 2018 at Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House, Salisbury, NC. Her graveside service will be 11 Am Saturday November 10, 2018 at Fairview Memorial Park with Rev. Brantley Moore officiating.

Goldwyn was born June 16, 1923 in Stanly County, NC and was the daughter of the late Thomas Irvin Smith and Pearl Bell Beeker Smith.
