Grady Wade Caviness, 73, of Albemarle, N.C. passed away Sunday July 16, 2017 in his home. His funeral service will be 11 AM Wednesday July 19, 2017 in the Stanly Funeral & Cremation Care Chapel with Rev. Randy Jackson officiating. Burial will follow in the Poplin Grove Baptist Church Cemetery with full military rites conducted by the Stanly County DAV. The family will receive friends on Tuesday evening from 6 PM until 8 PM at Stanly Funeral & Cremation Care.

Mr. Caviness was born on January 22, 1944 in Guilford County and was the son of the late Alfred Edwin "Babe" Caviness and Virginia Blanche Beam Caviness. He was a retired employee of the N.C.
