Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care of Locust is serving the Fink family.

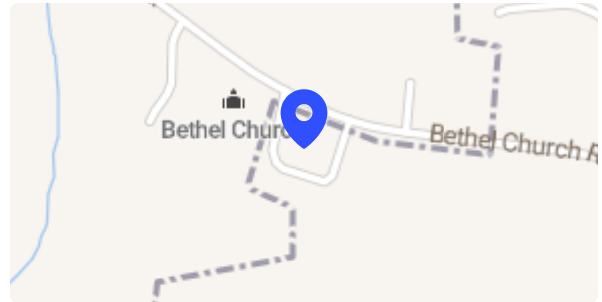
