Roscoe Lee "Skeeter" Huneycutt, 93, of Albemarle passed away Wednesday, October 27, 2021 in his home. His funeral service will be 3 PM Sunday in the Stanly Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Lee Church and Rev. Roger Moss presiding. Burial will follow in Fairview Memorial Park. The family will receive friends from 1:30 to 2:30 PM at Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care prior to the service. Born January 19, 1928 in Stanly County, NC he was the son of the late Homer Huneycutt and Maude Burris Huneycutt Kersey. Roscoe was a member of Union Grove Baptist Church. 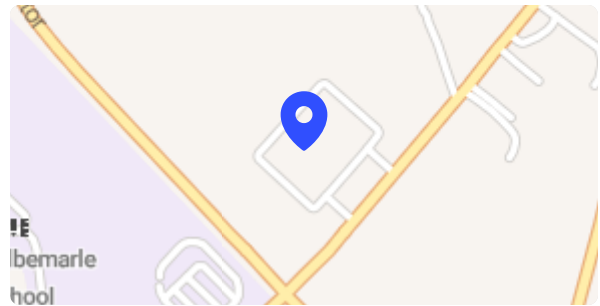

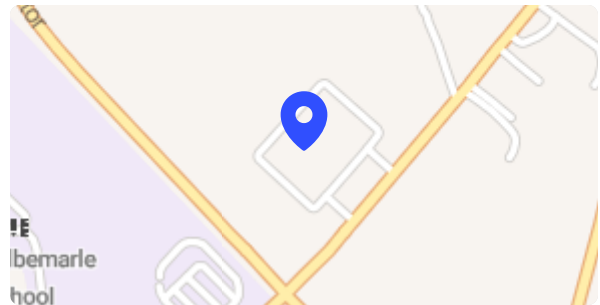
