**R**uby Juanita Forrest Smith Lambert, 93, of Richfield, NC, passed away Sunday, December 5, 2021 at Atrium Health Stanly. Her celebration of life service will be 11 am on Thursday, December 9, 2021 at Highland Baptist Church with Rev. Mark Lowe and Mr. Gavin Smith Whitley officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends from 10 until 11 in the church sanctuary prior to the service. 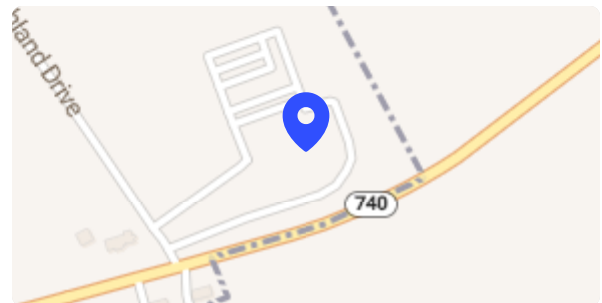

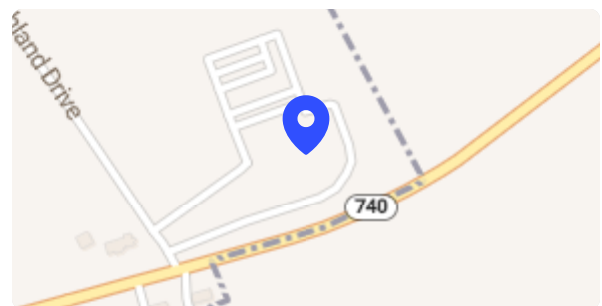
