**A**nn Greenwell, 89, a native of Charlotte, passed away Friday, February 18, 2022. A graveside service will be held on Wednesday, February 23 at 11 AM in the Stanly Gardens of Memory Mausoleum in Albemarle with Rev. Rodney Holmes officiating.

Born May 8th, 1932, she was the daughter of the late William and Fannie Caldwell. Ann lived in Washington DC at the start of her career with the government where she met her husband Lee Greenwell and both returned to Charlotte. Ann enjoyed the outdoors and time in her gardens.

Ann retired from the US Government Department of Defense in 1987 after 37 years. Ann and Lee moved from Charlotte to Badin Lake in 1988 where they spent their retirement traveling the country and visiting Lee's family in Illinois.

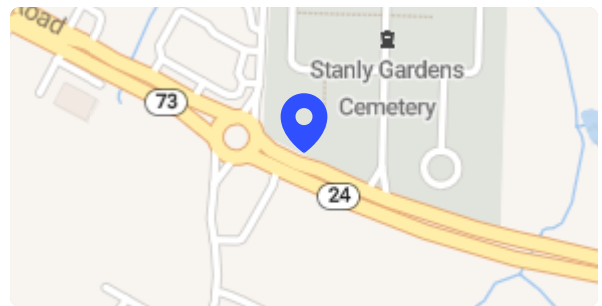
