Sarah C. Burleson, 88, of Rock Hill, SC, passed away Friday, August 19, 2022 at the Wayne T. Patrick Hospice House, Rock Hill, SC. 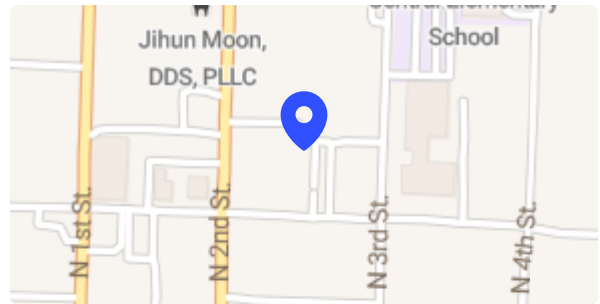

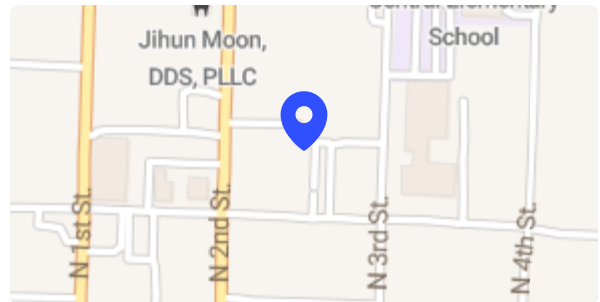
