# Jerry Dean Tucker

**J**erry Tucker, 67, of Locust, NC entered into the arms of Jesus November 24, 2023 at Atrium Health Cabarrus in Concord surrounded by his loving family. A funeral service will be held at Mission Church on Wednesday, November 29, at 2 PM with Pastor Jeremy Hyde officiating. The family will receive friends from 12 till 1:45 at the church prior to the service. Burial will follow the service in Oakboro Cemetery.
