Mr. William Raeford "Junior" McCain, Jr., age 74, of Monroe, North Carolina, passed away Sunday, November 8, 2015, at his residence.

A Memorial Service to celebrate his life will be conducted at 7:00 PM Friday, November 13, 2015, at Davis Funeral Chapel. The family will receive friends prior to the service from 6:00 PM until 7:00 PM.
