Mr. Larry D. Hilton Sr., age 76, of Monroe, NC, passed away Thursday, December 13, 2018, surrounded by his loving family at his residence.

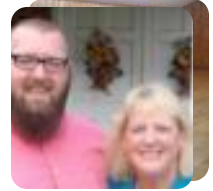
