Mrs. Janet W. Flanner, age 69, of Monroe, NC, passed away Saturday, June 19, 2021 at Atrium Health Main.

A memorial service for Janet will be held 6:00 PM, Thursday, June 24, 2021 in the H. Vann Davis Memorial Chapel of Davis Funeral Service, 1003 E. Franklin St., Monroe, NC, 28112, officiated by Rev. Mike Mullis.
