Mrs. Bobbie Jean Lee, age 87, of Monroe, NC passed away on Friday, October 29, 2021 at Mercy Hospital in Charlotte.

Services to honor Bobbie's life will be held at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, November 3, 2021 at Mountain Springs Baptist Church, 2509 Mountain Springs Church Road, Monroe, NC, 28112 officiated by Rev.
