Robert (Grover) Glenn Hill, Sr., of Davidson, passed away on Tuesday, May 14, 2024, surrounded by his family. A memorial service is scheduled for Sunday, May 26, 2024, at 4 PM at the Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care Chapel, officiated by Jake Lail. A burial will follow at Palmerville Baptist Church Cemetery. A visitation for family and friends will be held prior to the service on Sunday, May 26, 2024, from 2-3:45 PM.

Grover, affectionately known by his family as "Papa," was born on July 29, 1950, to the late Robert and Florence Hill. He is preceded in death by his precious wife, Sherry Benell Hill. Grover is lovingly survived by his son, Robert G. Hill, Jr. (Melinda); his grandchildren, Sara Roux (Robert), Cade Hill, and Lily Hill, all of Davidson, NC. He is also survived by his brother, Greg Hill, and his nieces, Madison Hill and Erica Sisk (Sheldon).
