Cathy Huneycutt Smith, 73, of New London passed away on Sunday, January 26, 2025 in Mission Hospital in Asheville. Her funeral service will be held at 11 AM on Friday, January 31, 2025 in the Stanly Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. David Cochran presiding. Burial will follow in the Bethany United Methodist Church Cemetery. The family will receive friends on Thursday evening from 6 until 8 PM at Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care of Albemarle.

Born July 19, 1951 in Stanly County, NC, she was the daughter of the late Richard Edwin Huneycutt and Aileen Hall Huneycutt. She was a retired finance officer with Crook Motor Company in Albemarle.
