Horace Keith Furr, 91, of Albemarle, passed away peacefully on Friday, May 9, 2025, at Trinity Place, surrounded by his loving family.

The family will receive friends on Wednesday, May 14, 2025, from 1:00 p.m. until 1:45 p.m. at Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care in Albemarle. A funeral service, officiated by Pastor Drew Edmiston, will follow at 2:00 p.m. in the Stanly Funeral Home Chapel. Burial will take place at Stanly Gardens of Memory.

Born in Stanly County on December 25, 1933, Horace was the son of the late Allen and Carrie Furr. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Margie Furr, in 2019, and by siblings Wayne Furr, Helen Hathcock, and Brenda Hill.

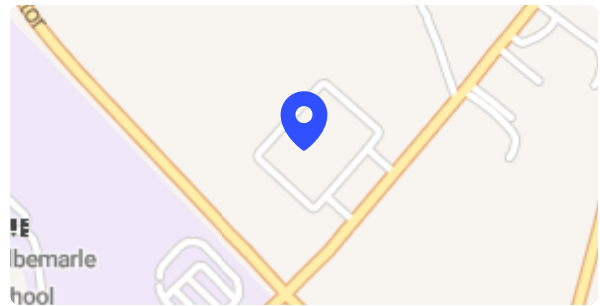

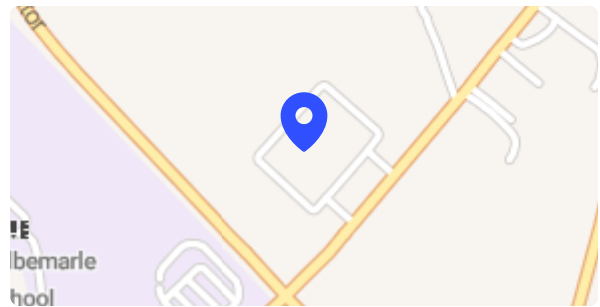

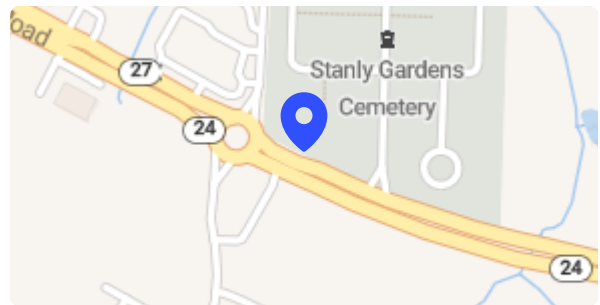
