Sidney Lee Smith, 77, of Richfield, passed away peacefully on July 21, 2025, surrounded by loved ones.

The family will receive friends on Friday, July 25, 2025, from 1:00 p.m. until 2:45 p.m. at New Mt. Tabor United Methodist Church. A funeral service will follow at 3:00 p.m., officiated by Rev. Katie Lineberger. Interment will take place in the church cemetery.

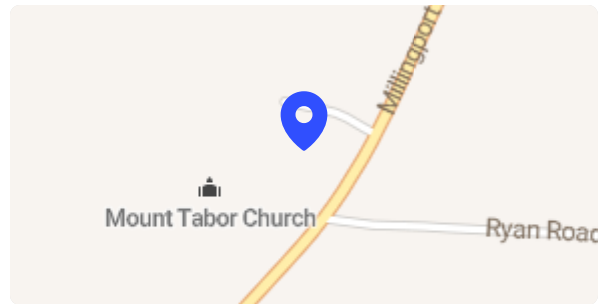

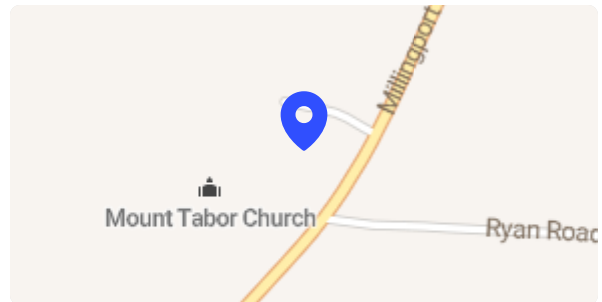

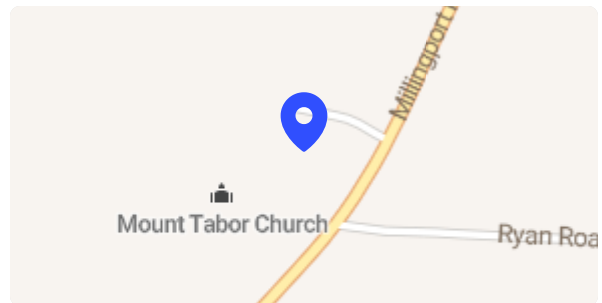
