Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care of Albemarle is serving the Miller family.

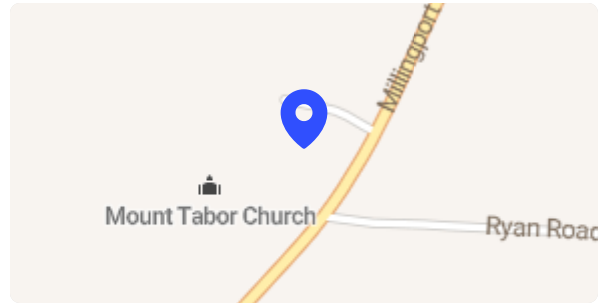

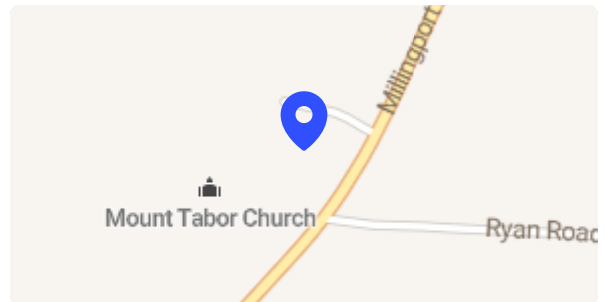

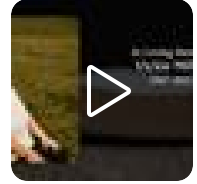
