Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care of Albemarle is serving the Bowers family.



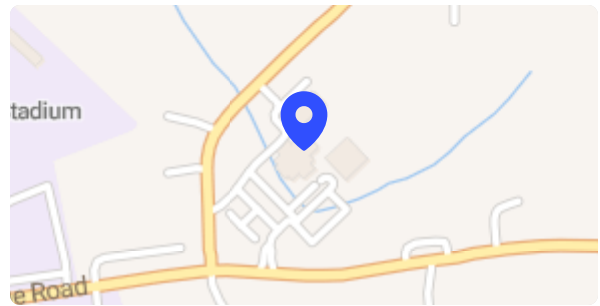

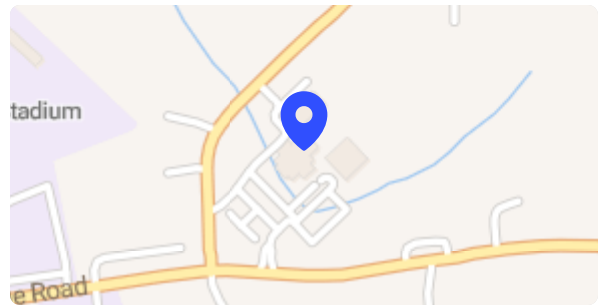

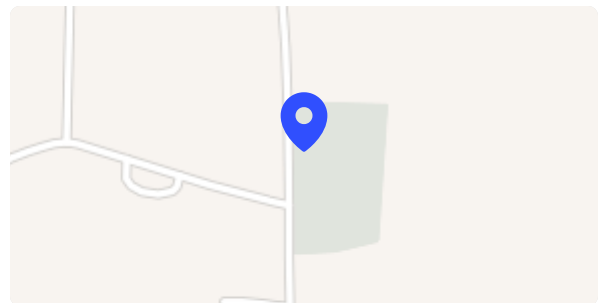
