William Gene Scott, 85, of Monroe, passed away peacefully at his home on January 5, 2026.

A funeral service will be held at 2:00 PM on Friday, January 9, 2026, at Davis Chapel, with Rev. Dr. Chris Baucom officiating. Burial will follow in Lakeland Memorial Park. The family will receive friends from 1:00 until 1:45 PM prior to the service at Davis Chapel.

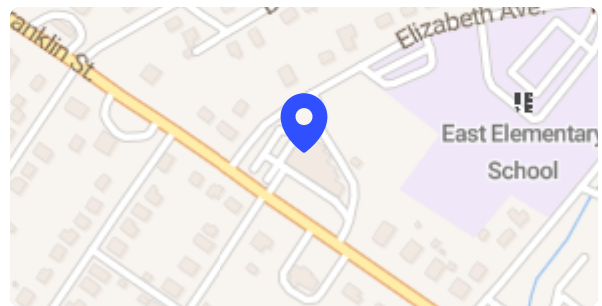

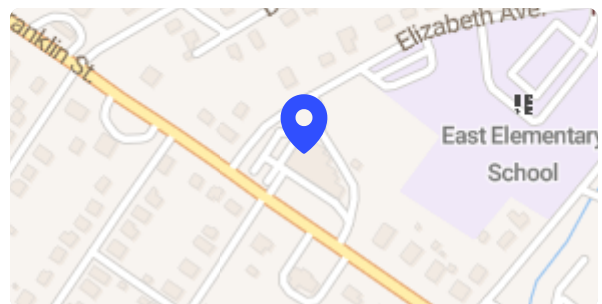

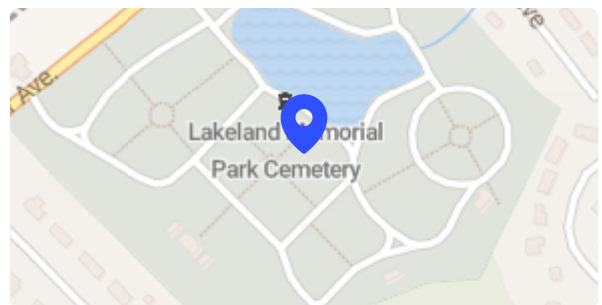
