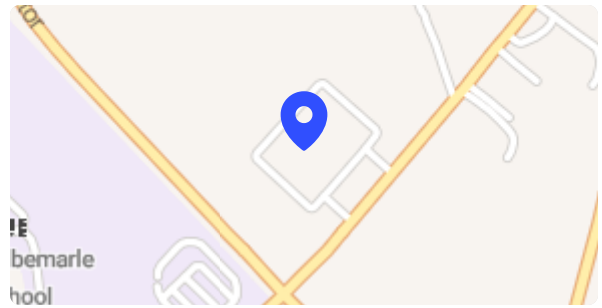

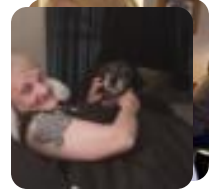

When I was a late teens back around 2002-2005, I had first met Frankie then. I met her through her ex, Jack Thompson because she would all the time come to my house and hangout with Jack and my dad. This was when my dad was alive and started to slowly go downhill steadily, but for surely with his health at the time when he had reached his late 40's and early 50's. Him and Jack Thompson were tight buddies at that time, and him and Frankie would come and visit at night quite oftenly. That's where that picture on the left came from, I think Frankie gave me a copy of it. I think this is when her and Jack went to the beach if I'm not mistaking!!! It was taken sometime around 2002-2004!!! Unfortunately, my father had gave up the ghost in May 2021 so it'll be 5 years since he died this coming up May of this year, and it's so crazy how time flies. It's hard to believe it's been that long. I never got to see her quite often after her and Jack Thompson had split, but I still had that picture of them at the beach. In fact, I keep it in my Bible, and will DEFINITELY keep now and always for memories since she ios now gone. I was already planning to keep it for eternity to begin with. Then in late 2024, we reunited. We actually reunited through another person at the time that we were both friends with that lived across the parking lot from her mother and sister, Blondell Moore and Sherry Hudson at the Edgewood Apartments in Albemarle. Of course, that old friend of ours had to split from us, I still think about, but because of what she was doing, we had to stay away. I still think about her sometimes though and wonder how she's doing and if she's even okay. But back to Frankie though, I definitely went to check on her quite oftenly since we reunited, but unfortunately, God had to cut that off real real short because he had different and better plans for Frankie. I was expecting for her to make it and hoping and praying to the Lord that her body would officially heal by itself since it wasn't doing her any good to continue her chemo treatments. To the least though, I know she is in a much much better place and is now better off because she's no longer suffering. I've gotta say though, it was definitely a pleasure to get her back involved into my presence because I knew how sweet she had always been even though she kinda had a tough road to travel during those times she had made her bad choices. My thoughts though, who doesn't??! I've always heard one of the most amazing Biblical quotes, not verses, but QUOTES instead which does make sense and is 100% true...."When you're not messing up and making mistakes then you're not learning andd growing!!!" Ntm, your mistakes and things you've done in the past do NOT whatsoever define you of who you are now. They may have changed you and made you learn a better strategy than what you use to do, but it still doesn't describe your life whatsoever. She was also basically like a mother figure to me as well. In fact, I was more than glad and grateful to be more than eligible to get her involved in my church which became her home church as well @ Pure Heart in Albemarle w/ preacher, David Pinion!!! Oh, and I can't forget the Bible Study and fellowships that she would join with us on every other Saturday with another church member that was the leader to those events, Jimmy Lee!!!! The good times I had with her though and hearing the Holy message on facebook preachings at her house on Kingdom Warriors with her laptop computer will also be another permanent memory that will always be in my heart forever also!!! It wasn't our choice; it was the Lord's!!! He knew when it was the best time to take her to her final and eternity home which is in her personal heavenly mansion while walking on the streets of gold!!! I'm really gonna miss her, but I know without a doubt that I will definitely get to reunite with her
