Gregory James Ott, 64, of John's Island, South Carolina, passed away peacefully at his home on Wednesday, March 4, 2026.

A funeral service will be held at 11:00 a.m. Saturday in the Stanly Funeral Home Chapel in Albemarle. Burial will follow in Liberty Hill Primitive Baptist Church Cemetery in Oakboro. The family will receive friends on Friday evening from 6:00 until 8:00 p.m. at Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care of Albemarle.

Greg was born August 10, 1961, in Sewickley, Pennsylvania, and was the son of the late Charles Edward Ott and JoAnne Elizabeth Thein Ott. He retired from Alcoa, where he began his career working in Badin, North Carolina, and later worked out of Knoxville, Tennessee. Throughout his career he was known for his dedication, knowledge, and strong work ethic.

Greg will be remembered by his family and friends as an intelligent, devoted, and loving husband, father, brother, and friend. Greg also found great joy in cooking, grilling, and baking for his family, creating meals that brought everyone together.
