# Nancy Priester Carpenter

**N**ancy Priester Carpenter, 94, of Albemarle, passed away peacefully in her home on Sunday, March 1, 2026.

Visitation will be at 10am with a memorial service to follow at noon on March 28, 2026, at First Lutheran Church in Albemarle.

Born July 7, 1931 in Stanly County, she was the daughter of Fred Laurius and Lela Mae Vick Priester. She was a graduate of Albemarle High School and Wake Forest University and became a teacher, having taught at Endy Elementary and North Stanly High School.

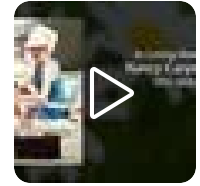
